Growth trend over the years





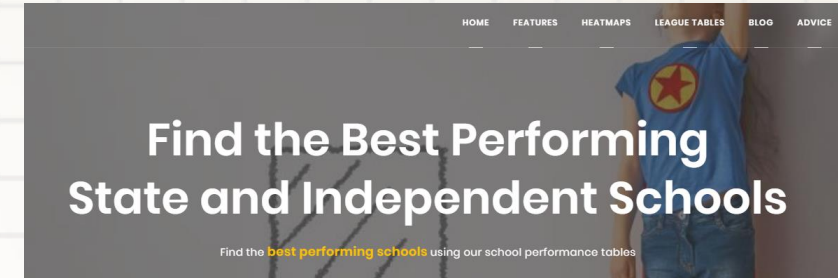
